Tinervin Family Foundation has pledged \$150,000 to upgrade Western Avenue.

Since January Western Avenue has distributed 1,800 food boxes provided by the Tinervin Family Foundation. In fact, we are celebrating 95 years at the same location this year. Through our recent partnership, I have learned so much about TFF and the amazing work they do in the community. On the horizon is assistance with all of our programming and plans to create a jobs program supported by the necessary educational and training offerings. Lasting change is hard work and it takes collaboration, leadership and communication to bring together the right people to make it happen. Friends.

The last four years, it has been a privilege to inform you and members of our community about the establishment of the Tinervin Family Foundation. Through your help and participation in our first four annual golf events, we have been able to turn our mission into reality.

This past year, we were able to expand our Christmas food basket distribution from 1,250 to 2,500, with 2,000 hams and turkeys and have set a new goal of 3,000 baskets for 2021. We also continued with our Toy Drive, Giving Tree and Adopt a Family programs providing gifts to those in need throughout our community during the Holiday season. Furthermore, we were able to maintain our ownership of a drug and alcohol halfway house, making necessary physical improvements to the house ensuring its accessibility to our local recovering community.

The Foundation has been busy working to enhance our current programs and initiatives by expanding our partnerships. It is through these valued partnerships that we can increase resource access to underserved children and families in our community. The Foundation will continue to partner with the Midwest Food Bank for our mobile food distribution programs. This year, we have added a new partner to assist this mobile food distribution operation, Western Avenue. We are delivering food directly to underserved neighborhoods, eliminating barriers for people who may not have adequate transportation to access local food pantries. Western Avenue, Woodhill Towers, Wesley Methodist Church, Healthy Beginnings and The Boys & Girls Club of Champaign are our current Bloomington & Champaign distribution locations. As the year goes on, we are hopeful to expand this program to other locations. We currently are delivering 1,200 boxes a month at these locations.

We are pleased to have been able to accomplish these initiatives without any paid employees and few office expenses, as all services essential to running the Foundation have been donated. Therefore, every dollar raised through this Foundation event will go directly to our community in need. I personally will continue to match any money raised at the event. Last year we raised \$210,000. I matched that amount and wrote an additional check for \$90,000 on December 31, 2020, for a total of \$300,000 in 2020.

Due to the Coronavirus shutdown, we have seen an increased need of food and support for our community families. We are thankful to have been able to meet that need, thanks to our amazing volunteers and partners. Throughout the year, we plan to expand our mobile food operations in an effort to meet the increased demand. We will need your financial support to help fill this endless need!

I have been overwhelmed by the amount of individual and community support we have received this year. I want to thank all our participants, especially our corporate sponsors from last year's event, and encourage you to please mark your calendars to attend the Fifth Annual Golf Classic. While this event not only helps us financially, it also has prompted tremendous awareness of our mission and initiatives. Please extend an invitation to your friends, family, clients, and employees to join us at this year's event.

At last year's event we collected 200 pairs of tennis shoes for kids. The Foundation purchased an additional 350 pairs. These 550 pairs of tennis shoes were distributed at Christmas. We will be continuing our shoe drive at this year's event. We want everyone to bring at least one pair of namebrand tennis shoes to our event on Monday, September 13, 2021. The shoes will be distributed Christmas of 2021.

Families are selected by organizations based on financial hardship and need—need for themselves, their children and their homes. During 2020, 54 families were adopted! Sixteen families were sponsored by donors and the rest were sponsored by the TFF.

Shoes for Kids

At last year's golf classic, we collected 200 pairs of tennis shoes for kids. The Foundation purchased an additional 350 pairs. These 550 pairs of tennis shoes were distributed at Christmas. We will be continuing our shoe drive at this year's event. We want everyone to bring at least one pair of name-brand tennis shoes to our event on Monday, September 13, 2021. The shoes will be distributed Christmas of 2021.

Support for Healthy Beginnings

Carle's Healthy Beginnings program works to ensure children and families have an opportunity to be as healty and prosperous as they can. This year TFF donated 15 car seats and 15 bus passes to the program.

Western Avenue Community Center

The foundation highly values its relationship with Western Avenue. This non-profit organization which offers many programs to support members of our community is a staple in our community. The Tinervin Family Foundation has pledged \$150,000 providing new signage, landscaping and more for their building.

United Way of McLean County

We partnered with the United Way to help provide some agencies they support with food boxes on a monthly basis. Organizations such as; Rural school districts, local Churches, Heartland Head start and others.
