### Mobile Food Distribution

We partner with Midwest Food Bank and Western Avenue Community Center. We have delivered 800-1,000 food boxes per month. Our mobile food distribution continues to expand. Our current list of distribution locations include:

## Christmas Food Baskets

The Tinervin Family Foundation has been delivering Christmas food baskets to those in need since the mid-90s. These baskets include everything to make a holiday meal along with a turkey and a ham. This year we will deliver over 1700 baskets!

We distributed 1700 food baskets plus 1500 hams/turkeys during the 2025 holiday season. We would love to do this again and need your help. We Need to raise \$100,000 to make this happen.

## Adopt a Family

Families are selected by organizations based on financial hardship and need-need for themselves, their children, and their homes. During 2025, 105 families were adopted! 40 were sponsored by donors and the rest were sponsored by TFF.

## Shoes for Kids

In 2025, we distributed several hundred pairs of shoes to children in need during both the back-to-school season and the Christmas holidays. Organizations that received shoes included WACC, the Champaign Boys & Girls Club, Carle's Back-to-School events, and our own Adopt-A-Family program.

## Homeless Packs

Our homeless packs are distributed throughout the Bloomington-Normal and Champaign areas, ensuring that vital resources reach those in need. We partner with organizations such as Home Sweet Home, Salvation Army, and Strides homeless shelter in Champaign, which play a crucial role in distributing these packs. Together, we strive to provide essential support and compassion to individuals experiencing homelessness, helping them navigate challenging times with dignity and care.

## Mobile Market

We hand out fresh produce and hygiene products three times a month at Woodhill Towers, Western Avenue Community Center and ISU Alumni Center in McLean County. We are currently in Champaign County one time per month. Anyone in the community can come without having to show identification and receive items. Recently we had added feminine hygiene items, toilet paper, paper towels and laundry soap to distribute.



## OUR PARTNERS

### MIRZA FOUNDATION

An incredible milestone this year was our newest partnership and the Tinervin Family Foundation's selection as a \$2.5 million grant recipient of the Mirza Foundation. This grant not only provides vital financial support for our work—it also serves as meaningful validation of our mission, governance, and growing impact. We are deeply grateful for the Mirza Foundation's confidence in our approach and for their investment in expanding access to essential resources for families in need. Their support enables us to build capacity, strengthen partnerships, and plan thoughtfully for the future.

### CRISIS NURSERY

In 2025, we contributed \$30,000 to support their mission and facility renovations including painting, buying new nursery furniture and updating their playground with new surfacing. We are also partnering with them to provide additional financial assistance for a kitchen renovation project due to begin in 2026.

We were honored to serve as the presenting sponsor for Crisis Nursery's 2024 & 2025 Gala and have committed to continuing that support as the 2026 presenting sponsor with a \$10,000 contribution.

### BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB (CHAMPAIGN)

The Tinervin Family Foundation is proud to continue its partnership with the Boys & Girls Club of Champaign. In 2025, we contributed \$50,000 to support a kitchen renovation—an essential upgrade that enhanced the Club's ability to prepare and serve nutritious meals to a greater number of children. In addition, we currently provide 50 food boxes each month to support families facing food insecurity.

### WESTERN AVENUE COMMUNITY CENTER

The Tinervin Family Foundation greatly values its partnership with Western Avenue Community Center, a vital nonprofit organization offering a wide range of programs that support individuals and families throughout our community. As a long-standing pillar on the west side of Bloomington, Western Avenue plays a critical role in serving an area where support is needed most.

A significant milestone is on the horizon with the launch of a 4.5 million dollar expansion project that will strengthen existing programs and create new opportunities to serve youth and families. This new development will be overseen by a dedicated, community-based team responsible for both fundraising and construction. The expanded center will serve as a hub for outreach and growth, allowing us to reach even more families in need.



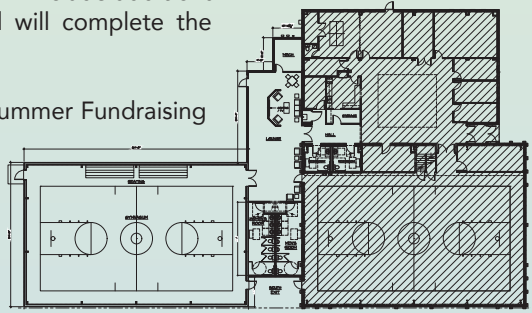
In 2024, the Tinervin Family Foundation proudly completed Phase 1 of renovations at Western Avenue. This included a new front desk and reception area, updated building signage, enhanced landscaping, a redesigned website, and other key improvements. In 2025, we finalized the addition of a new parking lot across the street to accommodate increased community use. This project cost approximately \$195,000.

Phase 2 of the project, with an estimated cost of \$2.5 million, is currently under construction. This phase includes a second gymnasium, expanded restrooms, and a new reception area, and is expected to be completed in fall 2026. The final



Phase 3, projected at \$2 million, will include additional classrooms and office space and will complete the overall expansion efforts.

In support of Western Avenue's Summer Fundraising Campaign, the Tinervin Family Foundation matched and pledged \$100,000 in 2025 and has committed an additional \$100,000 in 2026. We are proud to continue this initiative annually, helping to ensure the long-term success and sustainability of this vital community resource.



### CARLE MOBILE CLINIC

In 2023, the Tinervin Family Foundation helped secure \$750,000 to launch the 40-foot, fully equipped McLean County Mobile Health Clinic. Developed in partnership with the United Way of McLean County, City of Bloomington, Town of Normal, McLean County, and the Laborers' International Union of North America, the clinic delivers medical care to infants, children, and adults. The mobile clinic can provide chronic-condition screening and education, treatment of acute illness, basic wellness care and assessments, basic lab testing, social support and work alongside other community partners.

Operating four days a week, it serves multiple locations in Bloomington-Normal and rural McLean County. Some of these locations include Western Avenue, Woodhill Towers, ISU Alumni Center, ARC, White Oak Community Building in Carlock, Holy Trinity Church and Christ Community Church of Gridley.

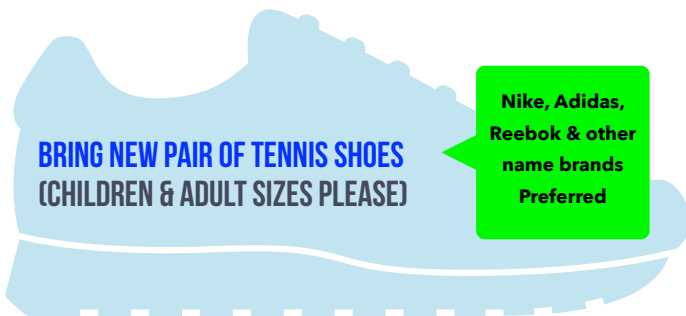
# SHOES FOR KIDS
